SATURDAY, NOVEMBER 6, 2021

SHOW @ 10:00 am

1. Open to steer & heifer calves of current year only. All steer calves must be dehorned and castrated.
 - Class 1: Prospect Breeding Heifer
 - Class 2: Prospect Market Heifer
 - Class 3: Prospect Market Steer

***NOTE:** 1st and 2nd placing animals in Class 2 & 3 will compete for OVERALL GRAND CHAMPION MARKET ANIMAL.

2. Exhibitors **MUST** halter break calves, sufficient to control in show ring, animals may be washed and clipped.
3. Entry PROCESS
 - **Entry Period for Previous Exhibitors:** September 1 - September 15, 2021
 - **General Exhibitor Entry Period:** September 16 - October 1, 2021
 - **No Late Entries**
4. Substitutions will be accepted until Friday, October 29, 2021. Any substitute must be in the same class as the original entry. **NO SUBSTITUTION FEE.**
5. Arrival Time: All animals must be in the barn by 4:00 pm on Thursday, November 4, 2021.
6. Release Time: 4:00 pm on November 6, 2021.
7. Tie Out Time: After 7:00 pm and return to stall by 8:00 am.
8. Weigh Time: Thursday, November 4 at 4:30 pm.
9. No cross entries from any Stockade Roundup Purebred classes.
10. Exhibitors may enter in the Junior Exhibitor Female Show at Stockade Roundup, entry deadline is October 1.
11. All calves must be tagged with CCIA Tags.
12. All breeding heifer calves will show in birth date order, showing youngest to oldest.
13. All market calves will be weighed and shown in weight classes, showing lightest to heaviest.
14. Entry Fee - \$70.00 per head PLUS \$10.50 environmental fee/head.
15. Straw Service for Tie-Outs - \$20 per head.
16. Additional Tack Space (4 feet) - \$100/exhibitor.

GENERAL RULES & INFORMATION

1. The show will be held under the management of the Lloydminster Agricultural Exhibition Association Ltd.
2. There will be absolutely no tolerance for verbal or physical abuse towards any of the LAEA staff and/or volunteers.
3. The show is open to all, but the Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry.
4. The Committee in Charge reserves the right to decide any point not covered by the rules and to correct any error or make any necessary alterations in the Rules and Prize List.
5. All animals being exhibited must be halter-broken and must be securely tied or in the charge of a competent person. No animals shall be allowed to remain loose on the grounds. **NO ANIMAL SHALL BE ALLOWED ON THE GROUNDS THAT IS NOT ENTERED IN THE SHOW.**
6. All animals on the grounds will be subject to veterinary inspection if necessary. No animal having a contagious disease shall be allowed to occupy any stall or building on, or be admitted to, the Exhibition grounds, and if any animal has been admitted through an oversight, suffering from any such disease, the Manager shall immediately order its removal from the grounds.
7. Tampering with animals to hide physical defects is prohibited. This includes surgical alterations, tranquilizers or any other practice that might misrepresent the animal's true characteristics. Any products/solutions/liquids administered internally to alter the conformation or weight of the animal is prohibited. Offenders will be subject to penalties imposed at the discretion of the Committee.
8. No person will be allowed to act as judge who is in any way interested in the exhibits that person is to judge.
9. The Exhibitors and grooms are to appear in the ring, neat, clean and suitably attired.
10. No animals shall have on or about it any prize colours or cards until the awards have been made in their respective classes.
11. No animal shall be considered by the Judges in awarding prizes unless the Exhibitor's number is conspicuously displayed.
12. Animals winning prizes must not leave the ring until the prize has been awarded to them.

Notwithstanding anything to the contrary herein contained, it is understood that each entrant by the act of entry or exhibiting waives all claims against the Lloydminster Agricultural Exhibition Association Ltd., and/or any of the members, officers or agents thereof for any injury, loss or damage which he, his employees, helpers and/or property may sustain in any way arising out of the operations or activities of the said Company, by any of his helpers or employees or their executors, administrators or assigns, and that any helpers or assistant introduced to or engaged by the entrant through the said Company or through its members, officers or agent shall be at the sole risk and responsibility of such entrant.

Exhibitors of animals are liable to occasional accidents, injury or damage to persons coming into contact with them, and therefore shall guard their exhibitors and protect the public from coming in contact herewith, and every such exhibitor shall indemnify the Lloydminster Agricultural Exhibition Association Ltd. from and against all claims and demands, costs, charges and expenses which it may incur, suffer or be put to, by reason of an accident or of any such exhibit not being properly guarded or the public not being protected there from. The Directors and Committee Members, will be taking every precaution, cannot hold themselves responsible for any damage to or loss of exhibits.
